




Travel Information & Map Falmouth:



By Train into Cornwall

[First Great Western](#) operate high speed services from London Paddington, South Wales and the Cotswolds to Cornwall, including [sleeper services](#) from London Paddington.

[Cross Country Trains](#) (Arriva Trains) operate services into Cornwall from the Midlands, the North and Scotland.

[The Maritime Line](#)

When arriving by train, change at Truro and take the Maritime Line to Falmouth Docks, a twice hourly rail service between Truro and Falmouth. Journey time is approximately 20 minutes.

By Coach

[National Express](#) serves Falmouth from destinations throughout the UK. Connecting services to Cornwall are available from Bristol, Birmingham and London. To book call 08705 808080.

By Road

The M4, M5 and M6 motorways have made travel to Cornwall simple and straightforward, while within Cornwall itself, the A30 and A38 continue to improve with fast dual carriageways. Follow the M5 to Exeter, and join the A30 to Truro, then follow the signs to Falmouth.

Car Parking

Pilgrim will be situated at Port Pendennis Marina Challenger Quay Falmouth. Cornwall TR11 3YL for embarkation & disembarkation unless advised otherwise. This is adjacent to the National Maritime Museum. There may be VERY limited free parking available (please call 01326 211211 for advice)

We would recommend that guests purchase a 7 day parking permit from Cornwall Council by calling 0300 1234 222 or by using the Ring Go mobile app on arrival in one of the long-stay car parks nearby. The cost for this is £35 per week (daily/24hour parking is also available) Please note that the Park & Float service from Penryn does not operate at weekends!

What Should I Pack for life onboard?

Here is a suggested list of things to bring when you come sailing:

As the British weather is unpredictable, you need to be prepared for a variety of conditions whilst onboard!

A layered approach to clothing works best so that you can easily increase or decrease your thermal protection as required. Stowage is always limited on a boat, and we therefore advise you to travel lightly and use a soft or collapsible bag. You can use the list below as a reminder and tick off items as they are packed.

- Glasses if you need them & sunglasses (with cord or strap)
- Footwear (soft soled, non slip and non marking i.e. not black)
- Gloves (fingerless are preferable if you wish to help crew the vessel)
- Headgear (sun hat with cord or strap or warm fleece hat depending on conditions)
- Jacket (anorak or wind-proof)
- Fleece or jumper (fleece stays warm even when wet, wool is much less effective)
- Trousers and/or shorts. Jeans are not recommended as they take a long time to dry
- Shirts (long sleeved, rugby/polo shirts or T-shirts)
- Underwear & socks (thermals if you naturally feel the cold)
- Toiletries & medicines (let the skipper know if there is anything you take regularly)
- Sun protection cream or spray
- Swimwear in summer (if you are feeling brave)
- Camera (we have binoculars on board)
- Sea sickness tablets if you think you may need them
- Casual clothes to wear ashore
